Billing Model Summary 2021/22

2020/21 Nassau Sending Districts

- Currently sending Nassau districts have a base enrollment. The base enrollment is calculated using the districts' three-year average enrollment (from each December) and the most recent years' December enrollment.
- The base enrollment figure is the <u>minimum</u> number of students they will be billed for in the upcoming year, even if actual enrollment is less.
- Districts are always billed for <u>all</u> students attending LIHSA, which is different than traditional CTE where a rolling-average is used.
- Tuition discounts are available for districts whose student enrollments exceed <u>either</u> their prior years' December enrollment <u>or</u> their base enrollment.
- Discounts apply to all enrolled students, not just the additional students.
 - o 3% for one additional student
 - o 6% for two additional students
 - o 9% for three or more additional students
- Discounts are calculated monthly to reflect actual enrollment for the period.
- Districts that do not qualify for a discount will pay the full tuition for the base number of students.

2020/21 Nassau Non-Sending Districts

- Districts that did not send students in 2020/21 will not have a base enrollment figure.
- If one student is enrolled, the district is billed the full tuition rate.
- For any number students enrolled above one, the discounts will apply to all students:
 - 3% for two enrolled students

- o 6% for three enrolled students
- o 9% for four or more enrolled students

2020/21 Suffolk Districts

- Suffolk districts do not have a base enrollment figure as the services are secured via a cross contract.
- Suffolk districts who participated in 2020 are eligible for discounts on <u>all</u> students, if they enroll more students than attended in December 2020.
 - o 3% for one additional student
 - o 6% for two additional students
 - o 9% for three or more additional students
- Suffolk districts who did not participate in 2020 are eligible for discounts if they enroll two or more students. The first enrolled student would be billed to the district at the full tuition rate.
 - 3% for two enrolled students
 - o 6% for three enrolled students
 - o 9% for four or more enrolled students
