
From the Principal's Desk for our LIHSA Families

In the Classroom: Guest Lecturer ESPN's Michael L'Etoile



This week, the Visual After Effects class welcomed guest Michael L'Etoile, Editorial Graphics Production Manager at ESPN. Students learned about his journey: studying Communication and Media Studies at Southern Utah University and working production at ESPN. As the Graphic Production Manager, Mr. L'Etoile oversees graphics production for many notable shows at ESPN, like *SportsCenter* and *Get Up!* He recently worked on the NFL Draft and talked about the working relationship that ESPN has with the NFL, as well as

other sports organizations and teams.

To get ready for our guest, the students watched the Friday 6 pm edition of *SportsCenter* and evaluated all the graphic elements that go into the show. Mr. L'Etoile answered student questions and shared insights into production and how the show is assembled. Students were amazed to learn how extensive the media library is at ESPN and how quickly content for late breaking stories can be compiled in a way that is highly polished and sophisticated.

One of the headline stories of the day was the growing rift between the Green Bay Packers and star quarterback Aaron Rogers. Students learned how the media is organized by production assistants, cut together, and transformed to relate to the story, including color schemes for the Packers and video packages for virtual composition.

If the name "L'Etoile" sounds familiar, we were grateful to meet Mr. L'Etoile through his sister, LIHSA Faculty member Natalie L'Etoile. We are so grateful for the introduction and the wonderful session this week. Thank you, Mr. L'Etoile!

In the Classroom: AP Art Students

AP Studio Art is a rigorous college level course that is through the College Board; however, it is not based on a written exam, instead students submit a high quality 15-piece portfolio for evaluation at the end of the school year. These were due May 20th.

Each student chooses a topic or a question that can be answered with a body of artwork, this leads to a "sustained investigation" involving a minimum of 15 artworks. Students have also generated a brief, yet concise, written statement that accompanies their sustained investigation as well as selecting 5 quality "selected works" that highlight their project.


This year's students are Avery, Hannah, Anays, Gabe, Khair, Alicia and Giavanna.
























In the Classroom: Rhythmic Exploration




End of Year Field Trips
