Wednesday, November 17th marked the end of Kathryn Markey's six-week artistic residency with the Acting for Commercials class.

Over the course of the residency, Kathryn worked with students to refine their presence in front of the camera, learn how commercial acting differs from film acting, and explore innovative ways to sell products by performing. Students from a variety of disciplines got in front of the camera and had an opportunity to be the 'talent' in a commercial. The students worked hard in front of the camera in class as well as at home, as the students performed 'mask less' slates so Kathryn could be a more effective acting coach, seeing a full range of expression.


