History, Holidays and Time of Year

The cycles of darkness and light in nature influences many different religions and cultures. Although winter is the season of dormancy, darkness and cold, the December Solstice marks the "turning of the Sun" and the days slowly get longer. Celebrations of the lighter days to come and nature's continuing cycle have been common throughout cultures and history with feasts, festivals and holidays around the December Solstice. This time of year encompasses the Christian and Jewish celebrations of Christmas and Hanukkah and includes spiritually significant days Buddhists, Pagans and Zoroastrians.

Advent: A period of four weeks in which Christians prepare for Christmas and meditate on the end of all time. In Western churches, the first Sunday of Advent marks the beginning of the Christian liturgical year.

The Feast of St. Nicholas: Some Christians revere the fourth-century bishop of Myra, a Greek province in Asia Minor. His reputation for piety may have inspired the legend of Santa Claus. The tradition of leaving gifts for children on St. Nicholas Day began in the Low Countries and spread to North America with Dutch immigrants.

Bodhi Day: Buddhists recall that Siddhartha Gautama vowed to sit under a tree in what is now Bodhgaya, India, and not to rise until he was enlightened. The title Buddha means "awakened one."

The Feast of the Immaculate Conception: A feast day that celebrates the belief that Mary, mother of Jesus, was born without sin.

The Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe: Observed by Catholics, the story of Guadalupe recounts a 16th-century apparition of Mary to Juan Diego, a poor Indian, on a hillside near what is now Mexico City.

Hanukkah: The Jewish festival of Hanukkah begins at sunset and continues for seven more nights. It is a remembrance of an effort to restore the Temple in Jerusalem after a period of desecration. Faithful Jews found only enough oil to light the temple lamp for one day, but the flame burned for eight.

Yalda: The Zoroastrian celebration of the winter solstice.

Ghambar Maidyarem: This holiday celebrates the creation of animals. Zoroastrians are encouraged to remember their practice of the equitable sharing of food during this observance.

Yule or Winter Solstice: This is the shortest day in the Northern Hemisphere.

Juul: A pre-Christian festival observed in Scandinavia, it featured fires lit to symbolize the heat, light and life-giving properties of the returning sun. Wiccans and other pagan groups celebrate Yule.

Christmas: This holiday has been observed by Christians since the Middle Ages as the birth of Jesus. Some Orthodox Christians follow a different calendar, and Christmas may fall on a different date.

Kwanzaa: This is a week-long, modern African-American and pan-African celebration of family, community and culture. For some people who keep Kwanzaa, the festival has spiritual overtones in its emphasis on Imani, Swahili for "faith."
