 Themes that should be included in the song: LIHSA, Graduating, Journey, Art, Creative Expression, etc. (Not all themes are necessary; select the ones that speak to you).



• **Performance**: Performer(s) will perform at the certificate ceremony as an acoustic performance or with a pre-recorded musical track. Please take

into consideration that we will not have a full band available to accompany you as you write this original piece.

- **Scholarship** will be awarded to the songwriter. If you need an additional artist to play music with you, we welcome another LIHSA Senior to accompany you. Only the songwriter will be awarded a scholarship.
- Auditions: Any LIHSA Senior who wishes to be considered should send a video of their finished song and lyrics to Ms. Rogan (<u>lrogan@nasboces.org</u>) by May 4th. A committee of outside musical industry professionals will review each submission and make the final selection.
- All students in any program are eligible to participate in this scholarship.
