A Field Trip: NYC & Surrounds in Media Class





Congratulations to LIHSA student Nathaniel Eck who won Huntington Arts Council's Sandi Bloomberg Dance Scholarship for 2022!


Nathaniel submitted a video of his performance in *The Nutcracker* that gained praise from the scholarship committee.

Classical Theatre of Harlem - Free Streaming Event




The Classical Theater of Harlem is offering a FREE stream of <u>CTH's ANTIGONE</u>. It is available on our website NOW until May 29th.
