Congratulations to 2022-2023 Long Island Arts Alliance Scholar-Artists Benjamin Schlaich, Brianna Smith and Annalise Taylor.

Administered by Long Island Arts Alliance, seniors who are selected as Scholar-Artists must demonstrate the highest level of artistic excellence, as well as superior academic achievement (a grade point average of 90 or above). Candidates are evaluated based on performances, a portfolio of their work and a written essay about how the arts have enriched their lives. Winners are chosen by a committee of arts educators and other professionals, with the final selection being made by a separate steering committee.


