A Sneak Peak at This Fall's Artistic Residencies



As a Career Technical Education (CTE) school, LIHSA's programs are distinguished by immersing our students in Work-Based Learning experiences (WBL). These are opportunities for students to work hand-in-hand with teaching artists with extraordinary skills and insights into their given field. LIHSA's WBL Coordinator, Iris Wiener, creates multi-week artistic residencies where top industry professionals work with students on engaging projects directly tied to course curriculum and create deep connections and powerful

work.

Some examples of partner organizations that are providing artistic residencies this fall include American Ballet Theatre, Urban Bush Women and Madison Theatre at Molloy College. Master Artists range from cameramen on *The Daily Show* to animators from the School of Visual Arts, to Broadway and Off-Broadway performers and acclaimed film producers, graphic artists, sound designers, and musicians.

Opportunities for Students: Dance Master Class/Audition

On Thursday, Oct 6 for both am and pm Dance students, we invite student to participate in a special dance session that is both a master class which also serves as an audition for the SUNY Brockport Dance major. Students will take the modern dance class and get customary feedback from the instructor. There is nothing for participants to prepare; please just wear typical class clothes (no shoes or socks).



The class is open to all Juniors and Seniors but only Seniors will be auditioning. Those students auditioning will fill out an audition form at the session and the audition will be used to determine any freshmen scholarships award from the department at Brockport.
