

In the Classroom: A Residency Spotlight



LIHSA students in Erik Chocianowski's Audience Management class have been gaining inside knowledge about the business side of theatrical projects through working with Mr. Angelo Fraboni, the Artistic Director at the Madison Theatre at Molloy University. Fraboni described the roles of the myriad people working at a theater, from the Production Manager to the Company Manager to the house management. Students were able to dissect actual contracts that have been devised for the performers and shows that come across the Madison Theatre's stage.

"You don't have to settle for anything," advised Fraboni, as he explained to his eager listeners that they can simultaneously be fair and assertive when compromising with others in the business. Students in the Audience Management class are excited to be working with Mr. Fraboni at live productions at the Madison Theatre this winter.




