

#### In the Classroom: A Master Class with Jeremy Kaplan





On Tuesday, November 29, LIHSA alumnus Jeremy Kaplan returned to LIHSA to hold master classes attended by instrumental music, vocal music, and sonic arts students. Jeremy spoke about his years at LIHSA, receiving a scholarship from Billy Joel, attending Berklee College of Music, and currently touring with his band <u>Dogs in A Pile</u>. Students had the chance to ask questions and perform for Jeremy who gave helpful feedback.

Jeremy talked about touring, band management, booking agents, songwriting, copyright protection, recording, publishing, and royalty details, concert bookings, contracts, and ticket sale and merchandising revenue.

Jeremy Kaplan is a composer and multi-instrumentalist whose main instrument is piano/keyboards. Jeremy attended the Long Island High School for the Arts for two years (2015-2017) from the Bellmore-Merrick School District as an instrumental music major. In August 2017, Billy Joel awarded Jeremy a \$20,000.00 scholarship which allowed him to begin his studies at

Berklee College of Music in Boston.



**A Visit from Norwalk Conservatory** 




Norwalk Conservatory for the Arts visited LIHSA after Thanksgiving and provided students the unique opportunity to audition for their college program during the school day. Performing Arts students met in the Main theatre to discuss life in Performing Arts and audition etiquette. The presentation also included an overview on the differences between college programs; BA, BFA, Liberal Arts and Conservatories. Norwalk shared their philosophy of students working professionally as they complete their degree.

Students then broke into smaller groups based on discipline. In Dance, Ricky Lee Loftus, Dance Department Chairperson of Norwalk, led a warm up and taught a fast-paced, energetic combo to "Dancing in the Street" from *Motown, The Musical*. Students learned the combo at audition speed, performed in small groups and all students received feedback. Students then performed again, implementing that real-time feedback. After dancing, students enjoyed a Q+A with Ricky who share his story and career path. "Students received invaluable and insightful information that will aide them in their future endeavors," L'aura Bagdziunas, LIHSA Dance Teacher, reflected.

Musical Theatre and Theatre students prepared song and/or monologue and performed for Daniel George, the Acting Department Chairperson. They gave feedback discussed the TV/Film program and Theatre programs with the students. 


