Earlier this month, LIHSA was awarded the distinction of being a "Premier Community for Theatre Education" by the Educational Theatre Association.

Rooted in EdTA's Opportunity to Learn Standards for Theatre Education, the distinction is <u>awarded to schools and districts</u> that provide teachers and students with the resources to achieve at or above standard as suggested by the National Core Arts Standards in Theatre.

This is a three year designation and we are the only school on Long Island and only one of two in New York State to be recognized this year!


